### URGENT! ACTION NEEDED TO PROMOTE ACCOUNTABILITY IN CSU FUNDING

**Send a message to your senator now! Decisions are being made on CFA-sponsored bill to increase public records access of campus auxiliaries**

Your action is needed to ensure that important legislation to monitor how the CSU spends its ever-dwindling resources is passed by the State Senate.

Senate Bill (SB) 218 – sponsored by CFA and the California Newspaper Publishers Association – seeks to update the California Public Records Act (CPRA) to include CSU auxiliary organizations, including campus bookstores, student unions, foundations, university enterprises and parking revenue funds, to name a few.

However, misinformation from the CSU Chancellor's office – which seeks to protect \$1.3 billion in on-campus auxiliary operating funds from public oversight – threatens to derail this key bill that could shed light on how money is really being spent on campus during this time of budget crisis.

Please join CFA in sending a message to lawmakers to counter calls being made by the CSU Administration.
