



## MONEY FOR INSTRUCTION

\$35 million for hiring more tenure track faculty. Students need better access to full-time, permanent faculty.



## STUDENT ENROLLMENT

\$62 million to expand access to more qualified students. This would mean 8,571 more students get a seat in the CSU.



## MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT

\$20 million to reach a ratio of 1 full-time-equivalent counselor per 1,500 students on all 23 CSU campuses.

## BUDGET DETAILS

CSU faculty and students support Gov. Gavin Newsom's 2019-20 budget proposal, which would add an unprecedented \$562 million in ongoing and one-time funding to the CSU's budget. We also ask for the funding to be specifically allocated to increase access for qualified students, increase tenure track faculty hiring, and boost the number of mental health counselors on all 23 campuses. According to CFA President Jennifer Eagan: "It's a new day for the CSU. This is an unprecedented start and a serious investment in our students and faculty, and we urge Legislators and the Governor to set in place these allocations, which will help ensure that the funding is used wisely."
