Chancellor Mildred Garcia is paid a base salary of \$795,000

On top of a \$795,000 base salary, Garcia receives \$80,000 in annual deferred compensation, \$12,000 in annual car allowance, and \$96,000 in annual housing allowance for a grand total of:

\$983,000
